

St Andrews Professional Licensure Disclosures for Prospective and Enrolled Students

St Andrews University Nursing program aims to satisfy professional licensure requirements in North Carolina. The Bachelor of Science (BSN) program prepares students to sit for the NCLEX exam and or practice within the state of North Carolina. Any student considering a BSN program that may lead to obtaining a professional license outside of North Carolina, should check with that state's Board of Nursing to verify licensure requirements prior to taking any degree program. Other states may have different standards. Please understand that St Andrews cannot sufficiently advise any student whether the BSN program at St Andrews meets requirements outside of North Carolina.

This disclosure is limited to St Andrews University's evaluation of whether its BSN program, if successfully completed, is sufficient to meet the educational licensure requirements of this state. The University cannot provide verification of any individual's ability to meet licensure requirements unrelated to its educational curriculum, as individual states may change their requirements for licensure or endorsement.
