Breadth Requirements: (16 credits)

Mathematics: a course in mathematics that develops an understanding of the appropriate use and limitations of quantitative analysis: (3 credits)

Natural Science: one science course designed to enrich a student's understanding of the natural world and the scientific method of inquiry; the course must include a laboratory experience: (4 credits)

Arts and Aesthetics: a course or courses selected from Art, Creative Writing, Music or Theater requiring either personal engagement in and critical reflection upon the creative process or the development of an appreciation of the aesthetic achievement of one or more disciplines in the fine arts: (3 credits)

Humanities: a course selected from the disciplines of English Literature, Gender Studies, Philosophy, or Religious Studies allowing students to explore written expressions of the human spirit in historical and cultural contexts: (3 credits)

Social Science: a course selected from the disciplines of Politics, History, Business/Economics, Psychology, or Education focused on the study of human society and culture. (3 credits)

Students must fulfill the Arts and Aesthetics, the Humanities, and the Social Sciences breadth requirements with courses outside of their intended or declared majors.

Fall 2024

ENG 290: The American Renaissance

Edgar Allan Poe, Walt Whitman, Nathaniel Hawthorne, Emily Dickinson, Harriet Beecher Stowe—how were these writers important influencers in America in the 1800s? During the first half of the 19th century as America struggled to define itself as a relatively new country and experienced the upheavals that eventually led to the Civil War, the political, social, and cultural climate of the country prompted one of the richest periods in American literary history. In this course, we will explore both the literature and the culture of the American Renaissance as we consider some of the best-known writers of the period as well as some writers whose impact is being explored more recently. We will read short stories, poems, essays, newspaper columns, and pieces from novels to help us talk about how writers of the time influenced and were influenced by ideas about war, science, slavery, women's rights, nature, and more.

ENG 390 Science Fiction

This upper-level course will consider the unique perspectives on the human condition offered by science fiction. Though seemingly concerned with futuristic settings or far-flung scenarios, science fiction reflects our own world above all. Rooted in contemporary fears and aspirations, it is a genre that writers from Mary Shelley to Margaret Atwood have used to explore human potential while grappling with questions raised by scientific advancement and cultural change. In this course, we will try to come to terms with sci-fi's engagement with the here and the now by studying a diverse range of science fiction texts and by examining the social, technological, and ethical issues that they address. As we consider well-worn sci-fi tropes such as alien invasions, robotic sentience, virtual landscapes, climate instability, and post-apocalyptic dystopias, students will practice film and literature analysis, enhance their critical thinking skills through class discussions and written assignments, and develop researched arguments about specific works of science fiction.

GS 290 Fair Play: Sports on Campus

Explore equality and fairness in collegiate sports from the 1990s to today. Engage in immersive activities and discussions that challenge you to navigate the complexities of collegiate athletics, resource allocation, and the pursuit of equal opportunities. Uncover the layers of legal and social change as you advocate for a more inclusive and equitable sporting environment. Open to all students, this is a interdisciplinary collaboration between Gender Studies and the History Department.

HIS 214 A Topics: Growing Up American: Children's History from the Colonial to Modern Eras

Dive into the captivating journey of childhood across American history and create your own childhood history. This course unravels the diverse experiences of young Americans, exploring how evolving societal norms, cultural shifts, and historical events have shaped the landscape of childhood. Uncover the untold stories of America's youth and gain a unique perspective on the nation's past and present through the eyes of its children. Open to all students.

HIS 214 B Fair Play: Sports on Campus

Final Exam Policy

1. All classes will meet at the time scheduled during the examination period.
2. No final examinations will be administered prior to the examination period.
3. Any exception must be approved by the Dean of the College upon recommendation from the Department Chair.
