Boarding at St. Andrews

Show Board \$750 per month (group turnout) or \$840 per month (individual turnout) plus fees for extra hay etc.

Available to students who are currently showing on the “A” or “C” hunter/jumper circuits or by special permission from the Equestrian Director. This is the only board available at the St. Andrews Equestrian Center.

To be placed on the Equestrian Center waiting list, a Request to Board form must be completed and returned along with a \$750 deposit and a recent video tape of your horse at a horse show or at home during a lesson with your trainer. Includes daily stall cleaning, 2 feedings of grain and 3 feedings of hay (coastal and/or timothy), water, group, individual, or no turnout, blanketing.

All horse owners are responsible for paying the farrier and the vet directly. A signed check must be left with the barn manager on the day your horse is to be visited by the farrier or vet. Billing can be set up if you contact the vet ahead of time and give them the billing information. All boarded horses are on the herd health care plan and will receive worming meds and vaccinations according to our schedule at the owner’s expense.

All boarders must be enrolled in the St. Andrews Lesson Program. Boarders are required to ride an average of at least 4 times per week and to maintain a G.P.A. of at least 2.0 in order to keep their horses at the St. Andrews Equestrian Center.

You will receive notification whether or not space is available at the Equestrian Center. If so, the deposit will be held and credited to your last month’s board. If you decide not to bring your horse to school and notification is received by June 1, then your deposit minus \$50 will be returned. If notification is received after June 1, then you will not receive a refund on your deposit unless another student’s horse can fill your spot. In which case, you will receive a refund minus \$50. All boarding fees are subject to change.
