Teach-Out Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Between

St. Andrews University, a Branch of Webber International University and

Montreat College

Effective Date: May 1, 2025 Term of Agreement: Through August 25, 2025

I. Purpose

This Teach-Out Memorandum of Understanding ("Agreement") is entered into by and between **St. Andrews University**("SAU"), a branch of **Webber International University**, and **Montreat College**to establish a process for providing currently enrolled SAU students with an equitable and transparent pathway to complete their academic programs. This Agreement is made pursuant to, and in accordance with, the requirements of the **Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) Policy on Teach-Out Plans and Agreements**.

II. Scope of Programs and Students

This Agreement applies to students currently enrolled in the following academic programs at St. Andrews University:

- Business Administration (B.A.)
 - Specialized study areas: Criminal Justice Management, Equine Business Management, Sport Management, Therapeutic Horsemanship Management

- English and Creative Writing (B.A. and B.F.A.)
- Forensic Science (B.A.)
 - o Concentrations: Chemistry, Psychology
- Health Services Administration (B.A.)

 - Concentration: Pre-Physical Therapy
- Individually Designed Programs
- Middle Grades Education, 6-9 Licensure (B.A.)

III. Responsibilities of Montreat College

Montreat College agrees to:

- Accept eligible SAU students in good academic standing into comparable or equivalent degree programs. Students with a cumulative GPA under 2.0 will be accepted on a conditional basis.
- Conduct individualized audits of each student's academic record and apply transfer credits in a fair and equitable manner.
- Waive institutional residency requirements to facilitate timely degree completion.
 - Montreat College offers online classes only through the School of Adult and Graduate Studies, with very limited availability to students in the School of Arts and Sciences (traditional undergraduate); transfers under this agreement would need to complete seated coursework.
 - As an alternative, students may transfer to the Montreat College School of Adult and Graduate Studies (AGS) as undergraduates, where all courses are conducted online. AGS degrees/majors differ from those in the School of Arts and Sciences (SAS). However, an AGS student may not live on the Montreat campus or participate in activities of the SAS, including athletics.
- Assign an academic advisor to each student to assist in the transition and degree planning.
- Provide each student with a clear, individualized degree map outlining required coursework and an anticipated timeline for completion.
- Maintain tuition and fee structures comparable to those at SAU, where feasible, or provide appropriate financial accommodations.

IV. Responsibilities of St. Andrews University

St. Andrews University agrees to:

- Provide official student transcripts.
- Provide an electronic copy of the 2024–2025 SAU Academic Catalog.
- Provide course syllabi for SAGE 230, SAGE 240, and SAGE 450, as well as additional syllabi or academic documentation upon reasonable request.
- Provide **major worksheets** for students, outlining program requirements and courses completed toward degree progress.
- Assist in facilitating communication and transitional support for students electing to transfer under this Agreement.

V. Terms of Agreement and Modification

This Agreement shall remain in effect until August 25, 2025, unless terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of both parties. This Agreement may be reviewed and modified at any time with the mutual consent of both institutions, provided such modifications are made in writing and signed by authorized representatives.
